

Scarecrow Contest Details for Christmas in Berthoud

Please join Christmas in Berthoud in our first annual Scarecrow Decorating Contest! Whether scary or funny, silly or ridiculous, this is your chance to express yourself or your business! Use your imagination, discarded old clothes, hats, gloves, and any other accessories you'll need to make your scarecrow unforgettable!

Scarecrow frames can be picked up at the Berthoud Community Library during normal business hours. Participants will receive an email with drop off instructions. Scarecrows will be displayed along Mountain Ave. until after Halloween. The top three winners will be announced and on display at the Oktoberfest in Fickel Park!

GUIDELINES There is no cost to enter, but we do ask that you consider donating to Christmas in Berthoud a minimum of \$10.00 per scarecrow. Other than the scarecrow frame, the materials needed to decorate your scarecrow will be not be provided. You may decorate your scarecrow however you like. Be creative, but please keep it tasteful! The Christmas in Berthoud board reserves the right to eliminate a scarecrow from the contest if it is deemed inappropriate. Scarecrows should not be taller than 8 ft. or wider than 5 ft. Scarecrows must be decorated to withstand outdoor elements (rain, wind, sun, etc...). Decorations should be permanently attached to the scarecrow frame.)
